

Hoka Hey Motorcycle Challenge
Policy for COVID-19 Rollovers



The entry fee for participating in the 2020 HOKA HEY MOTORCYCLE CHALLENGE™ was \$500.00 U.S. (Five Hundred Dollars U.S.) per motorcycle supporting one (1) rider. Applicants may have paid in full or may have made a deposit of \$250 U.S. (Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars U.S.) when their application was submitted. Those who paid a \$250 deposit would have had a remaining balance due before being officially accepted into the Challenge.

As per the Organization's standing policy for the 2020 Hoka Hey Motorcycle Challenge, there could be no expectation of refunds unless a documented medical reason could be provided. Participants who had to withdraw for any other reason could reasonably anticipate that their entry fee would be applied toward the next Event and they would be expected to participate in that following Challenge or their entry fee would be forfeit.

Due to the COVID-19 virus and the effect it had on the economy and our participants' employment, a larger than normal number of riders had to withdraw from the 2020 Challenge. Given the extraordinary circumstances involved, it was decided that all withdrawals made for reasons resulting from the spread of or effects from COVID-19 should be rolled over to the 2022 Hoka Hey Motorcycle Challenge, without exception. Rollovers from the 2020 Challenge will not be required to pay the additional \$250 to participate in the 2022 Event.

It was further resolved that, if these participants find they will be unable to participate in the 2022 Challenge they will be required to provide the Organization with no less than 6 months notice, with the specific reason they cannot participate. (Leniency may be granted on the timing if it is for medical reasons but a doctor's note specifying the medical reason must be provided). Whereas the entry fee / deposit might otherwise be forfeit if these riders cannot participate in the upcoming Event, the Organization will review & consider each situation on a case-by-case basis and the entry fee / deposit may be refunded. If a refund is approved and the 2020 participant later decides to submit an application for the 2022 Challenge the entry fee of \$750.00 will apply.

Any other participants who sign up to participate in the 2022 Hoka Hey Motorcycle Challenge and who later find they are unable to attend will be handled in accordance with the 2022 Hoka Hey Motorcycle Challenge Terms & Conditions.

If it is deemed necessary by the Board of Directors to ask any rider not to participate prior to the kick-off of the 2022 Event, a refund will be issued at the time the decision is made. The rider has the right to submit a rebuttal but, if the decision stands it is expected that the rider will honor the Board's decision.
